REGISTRATION OF POTENTIAL DEPENDANT

On the death of a member, pensioner member or deferred pensioner the trustees will ascertain whether there is a spouse, civil partner or dependant. If you are not married or in a civil partnership and would like to register the identity of your partner, or someone else whom you believe to be dependent on you, you may complete this form.

In the event of the member's death the trustees will need to carry out such investigations as are necessary to ascertain that the person nominated is financially dependent on or interdependent with the member.

Definition of Dependiant

“Dependant” in relation to any individual means the spouse, civil partner or eligible child of that individual or anyone who in the opinion of the trustees is (or was at the date of the individual's death) wholly or partly financially dependent on him.
